Robert Frederick Schroeder of LeRoy, SK, passed away at Humboldt District Hospital on Saturday June 8, 2019. He was 77 years of age. Bob, as he was affectionately known, was born to Otto Reinhard and Johanna Anna (nee Briske) Schroeder, on November 27, 1941, at home on the farm, in the R.M. of Prairie Rose in the Jansen District, with a midwife in attendance. He later went to school at LeRoy from Grades 1-3 with his brothers who took him under their wing and helped him through the hoops of school life. He attended Camp Easter Seal for several summers which he thoroughly enjoyed. Bob spent his days helping on the farm with chores, feeding livestock, helping in the large garden and in the fields. He picked stones and helped to fill the drill at seeding time. At harvest time he drove the tractor, pulling the hopper box to haul grain. This was his favorite by far. In the mid 1980's Bob spent a few years at Futuristic Industries and lived in a group home in Humboldt, SK. After this, Bob returned home to live with Mom and Dad in LeRoy where he enjoyed curling, bowling and shuffleboard. He was very competitive and he loved beating Dad! Television helped to pass the days. He loved action shows, like rifle man, war movies and John Wayne films. His next favorite pastime was eating, especially ice-cream. After Mom and Dad passed, his sister Adina moved to LeRoy to be his caregiver and he spent his final few years under her gentle, compassionate loving care. The family would like to thank everyone who spent time visiting Bob and making his final days meaningful.
